- Assist in broadening the Foundation's base of support in the community by identifying, cultivating and stewarding potential Board prospects.
- Participation in Foundation events and activities.
- Ability to work collaboratively with community and civic groups as well as federal and state legislators on behalf of the hospital on issues that may arise.
- Ability to be objective and free of personal, financial or operational interest in Dignity Health or the hospital/service area and a willingness to disclose any existing or potential conflicts of interest.
- Willingness to support Foundation Board decisions and a commitment to maintain confidentiality.
